The applicant must be a first year student attending Trent University in Peterborough, Ontario Canada.

The applicant must include their student registration number at Trent University so that the committee can confirm they are indeed attending and are first year students.

The applicant must submit an essay of no more than 500 words outlining what Kiwanis has meant to them or their family member and outline what the name is of the Kiwanis Club to which they are associated with. Feel free to include any volunteer initiatives you have undertaken in your community or elsewhere.
